Caretaker acquitted in death

A Forest Park woman did not cause the death of a 1-year-old girl who suffered a head injury while in her care, a jury has decided. Takola Glover, 28, was acquitted Friday of child endangering and involuntary manslaughter in the death of Jamira Chenault. Hamilton County prosecutors accused Glover and her husband, John Glover, after Jamira died Dec. 13. The couple had been temporarily caring for Jamira at the request of the child's mother. The couple took the child to Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center on Dec. 12 and told authorities she fell off a bed, prosecutors said. She suffered a skull fracture and died the next day. Takola Glover's attorney, Clyde Bennett, said his client was innocent and the death was accidental. John Glover's case is pending in Hamilton County Common Pleas Court.
